## TEAS Test Update



As of August 31, 2016, TEAS version V will be replaced with the updated **ATI TEAS**.

What else is new?

- Starting in fall, students will be able to do an online review after they complete the TEAS and receive their results.
- The fee is now \$50 to register through ATI testing and \$15 proctor fee to take the test at NVCC.
- A pop-up calculator will be a function of the test.
- Slight changes in the ATI test's content: more weight on Anatomy and Physiology, Earth science is no longer on test, slight redistribution of English language and usage topics.



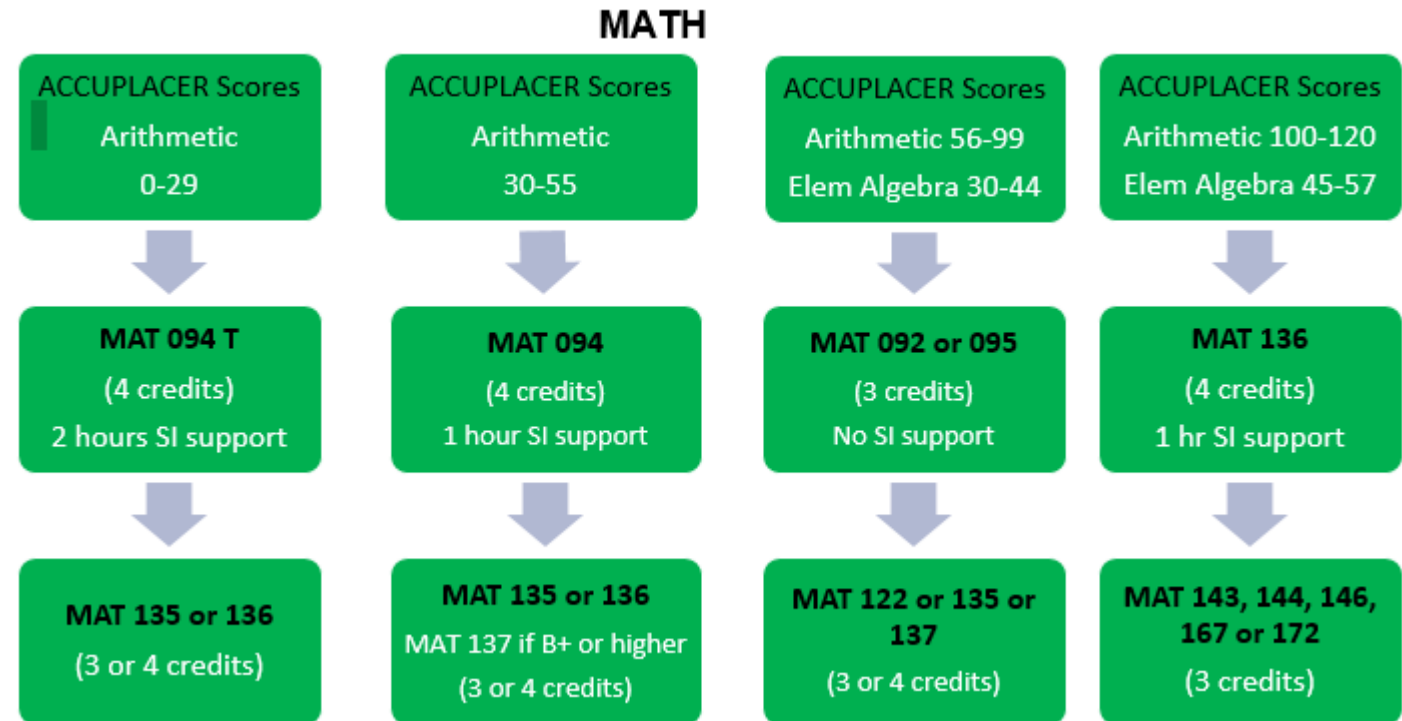

## SUGGESTED DEVELOPMENTAL COURSE FLOW FOR MATH



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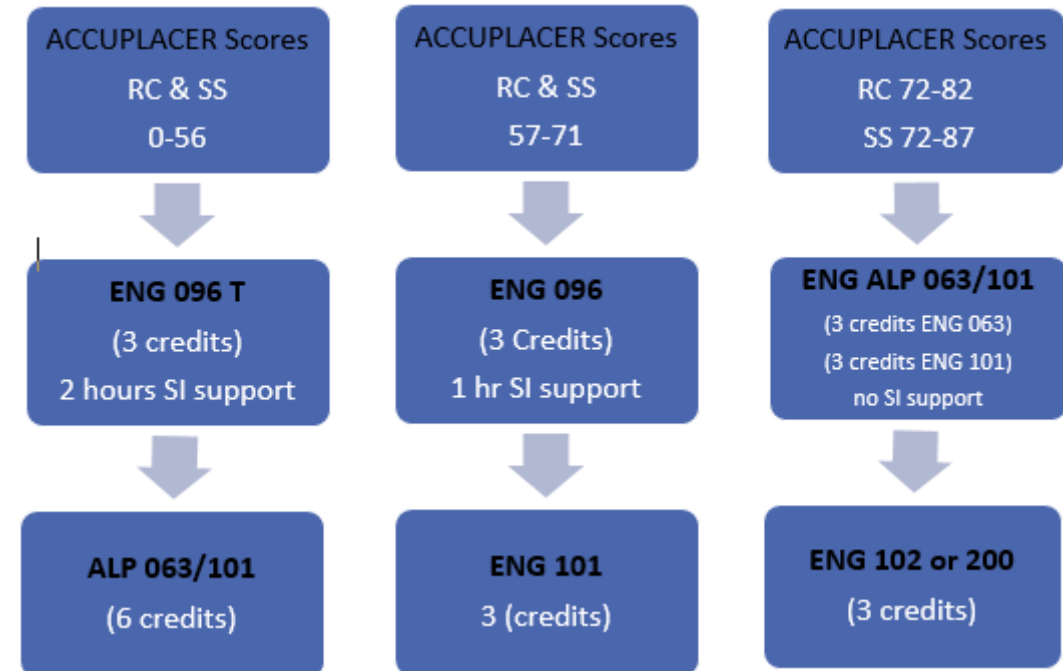
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## CHANGES IN DEVELOPMENTAL COURSE FLOW FOR ENGLISH

### How to Find Your Advisees in 4 steps

1. Log into <http://my.comnet.edu>
2. Select Banner Student & Faculty Self Service
3. Select Faculty/Advisor Services
4. Select Advisee List (may take a few minutes to populate)

### I have my advisee list, now what?

You can email students from mycommnet or export to Excel and use mail merge.

### Information to include in email. Sample emails attached.

- ✓ Remind new and continuing students to meet with you prior to registering for the fall or summer semesters
- ✓ Provide contact information including office phone number and location
- ✓ Provide office hours and any times you might be setting aside for advising
- ✓ Provide an alternative if advisees are unable to meet with you (e.g. Division Director's office, as appropriate)
