Advising Students in Developmental Math

Students taking MAT 094T or MAT 094

- If final (or mid-term*) grade is C or C+, students take MAT 135 or MAT 136
- If final (or mid-term*) grade is B- or higher, students can take MAT 135, MAT 136 or MAT 137

*If advising before final grades are viewable, students must understand that they will not be allowed to progress to the next level if they do not have the required grade.

What to do about a C- in math? Students who get a C- in the following math courses can move up a half-step with a waiver in Banner.

Students who get a:

- C- in MAT 094T can take MAT 094
- C- in MAT 094 can take MAT 095
- C- in MAT 095 can take MAT 136 or MAT 135
- C- in MAT 136 can take MAT 137

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Important Date Change for Fall 2017 Registration

Registration for continuing students begins April 10th for Fall 2017.

The date for Summer 2017 registration has not changed; Summer registration for continuing students begins **April 3rd**.

Registration for New and Transfer students for Summer and Fall begins April 18th.

- ✓ Provide office hours and any times you might be setting aside for advising
- ✓ Provide an alternative if advisees are unable to meet with you (e.g., Division Leader's office)
