Advising and Registration Steps

These are the general steps you should take in order to be prepared for your advising appointment and to register for classes.

- 1. Research your degree program and NVCC's General Education requirements.
- 2. Review your degree progress through <u>Degree Works</u>.
- 3. Review and tentatively <u>select courses</u> for the summer and/or fall using the Online Course Schedule.
- 4. Meet with me to discuss your goals, courses that align with those goals, and review your schedule.

- 5. If you have Financial Aid, please make sure everything is set for the next semester (<u>NV-FinancialAid@nvcc.commnet.edu</u>).
- 6. Register for courses online through MyCommNet. Click for directions on how to register.
 - a. Payment of student fees is expected at the time of registration.
 - b. You can sign up for an <u>Installment Payment Plan</u> which breaks tuition payments into equal monthly installments. The sooner you register for courses and sign-up for the plan, the more months you have to make payments (up to 7 months for fall).
