- BIO 105 Intro to Bio **or** BIO 115 Human Bio **or** BIO 121 (must be **with** lab)

Take Within 3 years of Application

- TEAS Pre-Nursing Exam (min. 53.3% Adjusted Individual Total Score)

Application Info

- Application period open Nov1-Feb1 for fall start. Students are encouraged to apply early.
- All courses required for admission and general education classes need minimum grade of C, except where noted.*
- Minimum **2.7 GPA** based only on the college courses that meet the nursing admission and nursing program curriculum requirements.
- All admission requirements must be completed prior to the application deadline. **BIO 212** must be completed no later than the spring semester of the application deadline.
- TEAS can be taken unlimited times. Only current, highest score will be used.
- Completion of this plan does **NOT** guarantee acceptance or admission into the Nursing Program.
