## Admission Requirements

Requirements designated with a ${ }^{\dagger}$ indicate completion must be within 5 years of beginning the program in the Fall semester. All require a grade of " C " or better.

- ENGLISH: Eligibility to take ENG 101 Composition (or completion of) as determined by prior course work or sufficient SAT, ACT, or Accuplacer Placement test scores.

- MATH: ${ }^{\dagger}$ Fulfilled by at least one of the options listed below:
- Intermediate Algebra (MAT 136 or 137) or higher level Algebra (excludes MAT 137L). Statistics may only be used if intermediate algebra or equivalent was required as a prerequisite;
- Accuplacer placement test score placing into MAT 172 or higher;
- SAT score of 570 or higher or ACT of 22 or higher;
- Passing score on credit by exam for MAT 137 or CLEP for MAT 172
- BIOLOGY: ${ }^{\dagger}$ BIO 115, BIO 121 or equivalent (or higher). BIO 105 is acceptable, but will not meet the prerequisite requirement for BIO 211 if taken prior to Fall 2021. High School Biology is acceptable to meet this admission requirement provided the course has a lab. High school transcript and course description must be provided.
- ADDITIONAL SCIENCE: ${ }^{\dagger}$ Completion of an additional High School or college level physical science. Transcript must be provided.
- GPA: Minimum 2.5 based on courses that meet the admission and General
 frame (including those sciences that are not admission or program requirements).
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## Important Application Information

- Application period is October 1 - January 15 for fall semester start.
- All pre-requisites and General Education classes require a minimum grade of " $C$ ".
- Current, official transcripts from all prior colleges attended are required regardless of age or applicability to program. This includes courses taken in high school that earned college credits and AP transcripts if using for an admission requirement.
- Completion of this plan does NOT guarantee acceptance or admission into the Radiologic Technology Program.
- Students are advised to review the current program fact sheet for additional requirements and to meet with an advisor when choosing classes to prepare for this highly competetive program.
- Mandatory information session will be required for all eligible applicants.
