Application Information

Application period is October 1st through January 15th each year for fall semester start.

- All pre-requisite and General Education Core classes require a minimum grade of "C".
- Minimum GPA 2.5 required for readmission or transfer within the program.
- All pre-requisites must be completed prior to, or taken in the fall or winter semester in which the student applies.
- Completion of this plan does **NOT** guarantee acceptance or admission into the program.
- Students are advised to review thoroughly the current program fact sheet, application and meet with an advisor when choosing classes to prepare for this highly selective program.
