**Take Within 5 Years of Application\***

- MAT 136/137 Intermediate Algebra (or placement into MAT 172 or Higher)
- BIO 105, BIO 115, BIO 121 or Equivalent (must be with lab)  
Only HS biology equivalent to college BIO will be accepted.  
AP Bio with a '3' or better on College Board AP exam required.
- Second Science (e.g. any BIO, CHE, PHY, etc.)  
May also be one the General Education Core science courses listed below. HS lab science courses are acceptable with a grade of "C" or better.

**Application Info.**

Application period open until Jan15th for fall semester start.

- All pre-requisite and General Education Core classes need a minimum 'C' grade.
- Minimum GPA 2.5 required for readmission or transfer within the program.
- All Pre-Requisites must be completed prior to or taken in the fall semester in which the student applies.
- Completion of this plan does **NOT** guarantee acceptance or admission into the Rad. Tech Program.
- Students are advised to review thoroughly the current program application and meet with an advisor when choosing classes to prepare for this highly selective program.
